Safety and Risk Factors Reported By Victims


- 31% of people receiving advocacy services reported the perpetrator used a weapon, including a firearm against the victim.
- 31% of people receiving advocacy services reported the victim missed time from work/school and/or a loss of income as a result of sexual violence.
- 55% of people receiving advocacy services reported the presenting sexual violence experience to police.


Impact of Services Provided

- 87% of hotline callers reported the services received were helpful.
- 92% of people who reported sexual violence had an impact on their emotional/mental well-being received counseling/advocacy services.
